

BEA LERNER VALOR AWARD Or. David Satcher



We are honored to recognize Dr. David Satcher, MD, PhD, with the Bea Lerner Valor Award. Dr. Satcher is a physician-scientist and public health administrator with an extensive track record of leadership, research, and community engagement.

He is Founder and Senior Advisor of the Satcher Health Leadership Institute at the Morehouse School of Medicine. Dr. Satcher served as 16th Surgeon General of the United States (1998–2002) and as the Assistant Secretary for Health in the Department of Health and Human Services (1998–2001). He also served as Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Administrator of the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry.

But perhaps his most important service was as a long-term caregiver to his amazing and talented wife, Nola, who passed away in 2019 after nearly 20 years with Alzheimer's. David has been a champion for caregivers and the important role they serve.

He has been an active voice in the Alzheimer's crisis helping to author the Alzheimer's Study Group report in 2009 that was a "wake up call" for America to invest more research dollars to combat Alzheimer's. He has been a member of the UsAgainstAlzheimer's Board of Directors since 2016.

The Bea Lerner Valor Award is given annually in honor of a person living with dementia, caregiver, or advocate who shows a commitment to raising awareness and brings determination, hope and humor in the fight against Alzheimer's disease. Previous recipients have included Mandy Moore (2020), Seth and Lauren Rogen (2019), Lynda Everman (2018), Daisy Duarte (2017), and Greg O'Brien (2016).

CONGRESSIONAL CHAMPION AWARD

Senator Robert Menendez



Senator Bob Menendez, (D-NJ), the recipient of our 2021 Congressional Champion Award, has been a strong leader in the U.S. Senate for increased federal funding for Alzheimer's research and a peerless advocate for heath equity for Black Americans and Latinos in our nation's response to this disease.

A senior member of the Senate Finance Committee, Senator Menendez has helped lead efforts to ensure that communities of colors—which have disproportionately higher rates of Alzheimer's—have access to health services and clinical trials. He has also pushed for commitments for health equity during confirmation hearings for senior federal leaders and has introduced legislation to increase diversity among participants in clinical trials.

On behalf of the more than 6 million Americans living with Alzheimer's and 14 million caregivers, UsAgainstAlzheimer's thanks Senator Menendez for his work on these critically important issues.

The Congressional Champion Award recognizes a leader in the efforts to end this disease. Alzheimer's disease strikes without regard to party affiliation and stopping it has always been a bipartisan effort. Past winners of our Congressional Champion Award have included Senator Patty Murray (D-WA); Senator Shelley Moore Capito (R-WV); Senator Roy Blunt (R-MO); Senator Debbie Stabenow (D-MI); Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-CA); Senator Kelly Ayotte (D-NH); Senator Barbara Mikulski (D-MD); and Senator Susan Collins (R-ME).




