
WE CAN STOP ALZHEIMER'S. (UNLESS CONGRESS STOPS US.)

- Without Congressional action, the sequester will slash \$2 billion from essential biomedical research aimed at reducing future Medicare and Medicaid expenditures.
- From polio to cancer, heart disease to HIV/AIDS, we have seen that a commitment to research and discovery pays off and is a COST-REDUCTION strategy.
- As more than 320 leading researchers dedicated to reaching the national goal of stopping Alzheimer's by 2025, we call on Congress to reject devastating cuts to life-saving and cost-reducing medical research. Protect the federal investment that is essential to accelerating our work toward a cure.
